

Ethics Complaint Form

(This Complaint form should be filed with the Town of Boston Ethics Committee)

Any person may file a complaint if he or she has information that a public officer or employee has violated the Ethics Ordinance. It is not enough to merely allege that a public officer or employee has acted improperly. A Complaint must contain factual information supporting the allegation(s) that one or more of the Standards of Conduct contained in the Ethics Ordinance have been violated.

This Form is not required, but is encouraged as a Complaint must be in writing. A Complaint should be filed with the Ethics Committee by mail at: Town of Boston Ethics Committee, 8500 Boston State Road, Boston, New York 14025-9648 or via e-mail at ethics@townofboston.com within a timely manner to aid in an investigation. The anonymity of the complainant will be maintained to the extent possible.
