

## Town Board Minutes December 3, 2008

Present: Supervisor William A. Eagan, Councilmen Richard K. Hawkins and James E. Pluta, Councilwomen Cathleen M. Dobson and Cathy A. Maghran.

Also Present: Town Attorney Downey and Code Enforcement Officer's Ferguson and Lisowski.

Reverend Laun, Churchill Memorial United Methodist Church opened the meeting with a prayer.

A motion was made by Supervisor Eagan and was seconded by Councilman Hawkins to approve the minutes of the 11/19/08 meeting.

A motion was made by Councilman Pluta and seconded by Councilman Hawkins upon review by the Town Board that fund bills on the Abstract dated December 1, 2008, in the amount of \$138,425.12 be paid.

Supervisor Eagan read a letter from Don Wohlhueter of 4668 Pinecrest Terrace thanking The Boston Highway Superintendent and department employees for their efficient and timely pick up of the leaves this year.

Supervisor Eagan added that the Town Board appreciates the work being done by the Highway Department. He noted that the Town Board did fund the leaf and brush pick up again for 2009 and believes that the community is entitled to this service.

Received and filed resolutions from Towns of Brant, Marilla and Clarence in regards to the Cornell Cooperative Extension and the Erie County soil and Water Conservation District.

A motion was made by Supervisor Eagan and was seconded by Councilman Hawkins to reappoint Robert J. Ganey to the Assessment Board of Review term to expire 9/30/ 2013.

He stated that there is a question of proximity.

A motion was made by Supervisor Eagan and was seconded by Councilwoman Dobson to table the Application for an Additional Accessory Building from Paul and Deborah Kaczmarski, 6577 Kevinton Place, until information is received from the Zoning Board of Appeals and the Code Enforcement Officers.
